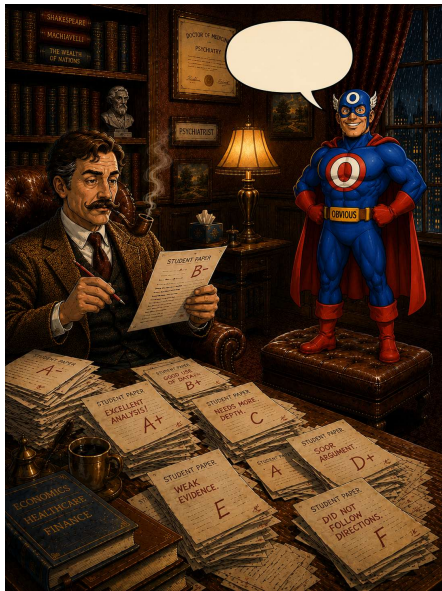
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- Your eyes do not deceive you.

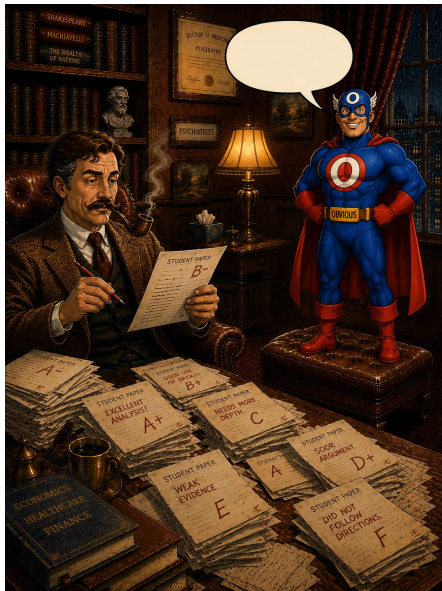

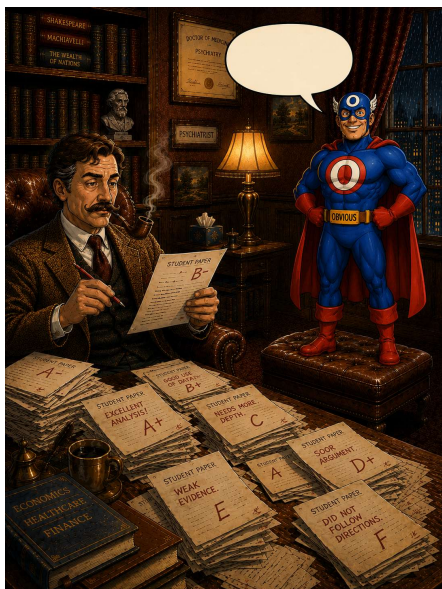

 - Middle managers require supervision and oversight themselves, leading to an additional managerial layer.

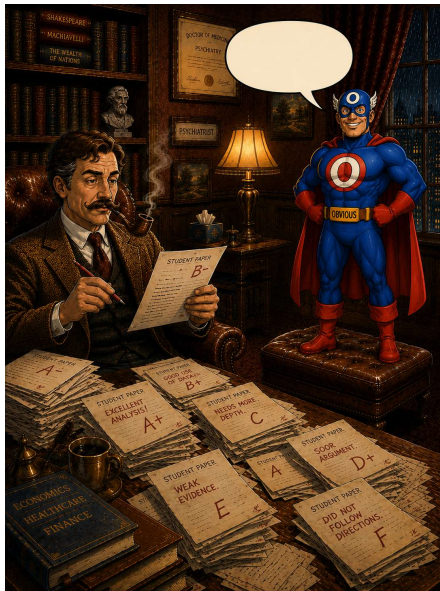
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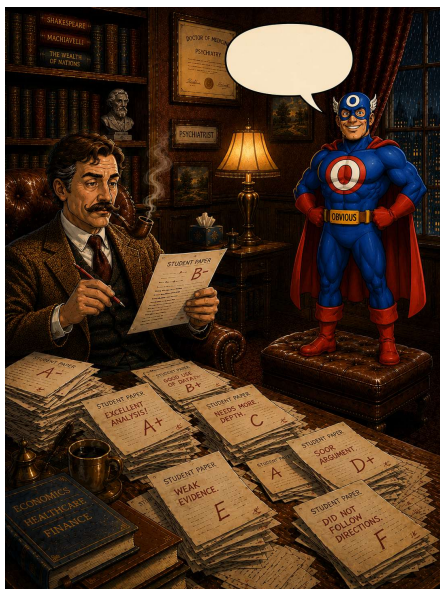
